



The Competition Council has sanctioned 25 roads construction companies for failing to provide information

The Competition Council has sanctioned 25 companies involved in construction of roads and highways with a fine of Ron 1,869,438 lei (the equivalent of Eur 429,410) for failing to provide information within sector inquiry on construction of roads and highways.

Within the sector inquiry, questionnaires were sent to undertakings activating in roads and highways construction sector (constructors, designers, consultants, suppliers of construction materials, etc.) concerning the activity of companies (works performed, participation in tenders, associates, subcontractors) and problems on the market.

The analysis of roads and highways construction market has as main goal the identification of functioning mechanisms of the market in order to discover and correct any malfunctioning of anti-competitive nature.

The sector inquiry is a complex tool by which the Competition Council assesses the state of competition either on a national market or in a field. Under the Competition Law (no. 21/1996) the failure to provide information is sanctioned by fine from 0.1% to 1% of total turnover of the company.
